Intended purpose

The HEWI rail system is designed for use in bathrooms. It provides a gripping option for persons with or without physical disability when they shower or take a bath.

- Ensure that the product is installed, maintained and repaired by qualified, skilled personnel only.
- Check the product for damage on acceptance. Report defects immediately.
- Install/use the product only:
 - in accordance with its intended purpose
 - in its original condition without modifications
 - in perfect condition
- Use original spare parts only.
- Only use the HEWI fixing materials included.
- Only use in closed rooms.

Cleaning

CAUTION! Risk of injury

- Do not use any products with unknown composition.
- A detailed list of suitable cleaning products is available from our support service on request.


Unsuitable cleaning products

- Abrasive products/objects (e.g. scouring agents, scourer sponge, brushes, steel wool, microfibers, dirt erasers)
- Alkaline, acidic and chlorine-based cleaning products, solvents
- Steam cleaners
- Do not treat metal components with objects containing iron (e.g. scourer sponge, steel wool).

This product uses metric socket screws. If using imperial hex keys, please choose an appropriate size.





CAUTION!




Too wide support spacings will reduce the stability of the grab rail and wall supports and may lead to injuries due to falling. Observe maximum support spacings.

Risk of injury


Grab rails installed in any other than a horizontal position may lead to injuries due to slipping or falling. Install grab rails in a horizontal position.

Any improper use, e.g. as a gymnastic apparatus or climbing aid, may lead to injuries due to slipping or falling. Use grab rails only for support.


